POSITION OVERVIEW

Beecuz is for workshop facilitators, who are eager to spread the buzz! Each workshop facilitator is paired with a classroom in the community, and is responsible for teaching the Beecuz curriculum to students, as well as communicating with teachers and helping them fulfill their role in the program. From October-December, facilitators undergo weekly training that engages them with the curriculum content, and provides a thorough understanding of the skills necessary to effectively engage students. Facilitators also receive invaluable, professional mental health training, thereby ensuring that they are comfortable navigating difficult situations. Facilitators are then responsible for actively working with schools to deliver the educational program from January-April. We are looking for individuals who are enthusiastic, engaged, and determined to make a positive difference in the community!

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend weekly training sessions from October-December
- Participate in mental health training (ex. SAFETalk, mental health first aid)
- Host biweekly workshops at the designated elementary school from January-April
- Communicate with teachers and Beecuz executive members about program implementation
- Contribute to community events (based on individual availability)
